The End of the Third Wave and the Global Future of Democracy

The "Third Wave" of global democratization, which began in 1974, now appears to be drawing to a close. While the number of "electoral democracies" has tripled since 1974, the rate of increase has slowed every year since 1991 (when the number jumped by almost 20 percent) and is now near zero.
